Rules of Shooting:

- All shooting equipment is subject to inspection due to changes in Rules regarding Record status shoots
- UK record status has been awarded for this event which will be shot to Archery GB rules (timing to method 2), (3 ARROWS IN 2 MINUTES) competitors must comply with Archery GBs dress regulations - rule 307.
- Record Status tournaments are liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result.
- It is a requirement of Record Status events that parents/guardians of juniors entering a Record Status competition must sign the entry form to give consent for drug testing.
- Under the provisions within the Archery GB's Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are to register with the Tournament Organiser on arrival. Whilst every effort will be made to ensure that unauthorised photography does not take place, Archery GB, the Tournament organiser and working party cannot be held responsible for breaches of this code. We therefore request that you report any unauthorised photography directly to the Tournament Organiser.
- The organisers cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to equipment or personal possessions.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Archery GB cards shall be produced if requested.
2. Soft soled shoes must be worn in the sports hall.
3. Food and drink may not be consumed in the sports hall.
4. Smoking is not allowed in the recreation centre.

NWAS trophies will be awarded for the **NWAS CHAMPIONSHIPS** ON A SINGLE ROUND, THE "A" **SINGLE PORTSMOUTH ROUND OR THE FIRST SESSION OF THE DOUBLE ROUND** FOR ARCHERS SHOOTING THE DOUBLE. Compound archers will only qualify for trophies shooting on 3 spot faces .

VISITORS

Trophies for the Single or Double. (not both) Compound archers will only qualify for trophies shooting on 3 spot faces .
