Accreditation	Archery GB membership card must be produced at the registration. Awards will be according to entries received by the closing date. Soft soled shoes must be worn in the sports hall. Food and drink may not be consumed in the sports hall. Smoking is not allowed in the recreation centre.																
Awards	Trophies will be awarded for the Single Round and Double Round. Archers shooting the double will be eligible for the double award only. The awards ceremony for the Single Round will be held at the end of Session A.
